- Fiscal responsibility and further accountability
- Are we paying the correct fees for each individual age?
- Roster assembly changes (1 goalie per team, roster size) due to available ice and financial commitments
- Revamped Initiation Program
- We are purchasing rink dividers and implement Hockey Canada guidelines for cross ice training and development
- Additional <u>Initiation</u> Ice time dedicated mid week for additional/professional training and Goalie training throughout HL
- Tournament Play
 - Local: Tyke Jamboree, Presidents Cup, Mike Mulvaney Tournament, and Atom Liftlock Tournament
 - PHA Roster Select Program
 - The RS program will exist with fewer teams due to ice issues (Novice, Atom, Peewee, Minor Bantam)
 - Need new leader, lead by team effort

 - PHA Roster Select Program
 - The RS program ran with Teams in Minor Atom, Atom, Minor Peewee, Peewee, and Minor Bantam
 - Tyke Select Program to move to Rep Side
 - Have a Roster Select Convenor again to assist in running the RS Program

- Completed updated Registration policy for registering and paying for House League and Rep Hockey
 - Transitioned Player registration from PHA Website and PayPal to the Hockey Canada online registration and payment system.
 - Utilizing the Hockey Canada registration system helped streamline the administration process helping enforce OMHA rules around rostering and participating in hockey
 - 100% of registration payments collected by deadline
- Continued support and use of new financial assistance model "PHA Cares" offering financial assistance for families to play all levels of hockey
 - Set criteria
 - Set timelines
 - Set procedures to ensure utmost privacy & professionalism

- Continued use of non cash transactions by automatic deposit to referees, timekeepers and suppliers
- New season training for managers on banking, budgeting and reporting requirements
- Monitor and review monthly reporting by rep teams to parents, follow up as necessary
- Continue relationship with both banking partners (KCU & Scotiabank)
- Standardize sponsorship requirements and sponsorship packages with rep sponsor
- Provide variance analysis for monthly actuals vs budget
