

Township of Douro-Dummer Recreation Facilities Information

All Provincially required protocols must also be followed including;

- Physically distancing—those who do not reside together must maintain 2 meters distance from each other.
- Wearing a face covering while in public spaces (signage throughout the facilities for reminder that face coverings are necessary).
- Participants must wear a face covering until the skates are tied and helmets are on.
- Organization officials must wear a face covering and necessary PPE (eye protection) while on the bench and any time they are within 2 metres of someone who is not using a face covering
- All visitors should stay home if they are showing any signs or symptoms of COVID 19.
 - Actively screening of employees and visitors is taking place using the provincial standard screening tool and keeping a log of individuals utilizing the facilities for contact tracing.
 - Participants and visitors must submit contact tracing and screening tools before they enter the facilities.
- Sanitizing your hands frequently.
- Front entrance doors will not be open between rentals
- No in-and-outs of the facility will be allowed
- All participants/spectators must enter and exit through the designated doors and following the directional signage in the facility and instructions from staff.
- Public washrooms in the lobby washrooms will be available for use, with limited capacity, every other stall available. The washrooms will be locked and visitors will have to ask for access. Washrooms are sanitized after each use.
- Absolutely no outside food may be brought into the facility(s).

Capacities While in Yellow Zone:

- Businesses or Organizations: maximum 30 people on ice surface and maximum
 47 people in the facilities
- o Private Rentals: Maximum of 10 people on ice surface/facilities
- Facilities will only be rented to those groups and persons who reside in the catchment area of the Peterborough Health Unit

General Protocols:

- All ice time in stages 1, 2 and 3 will be 45 minutes in duration allowing for 15 minutes of disinfection of the Douro Community Centre by Township staff.
 Standard ice time slots will be 60 minutes.
- Access to the facility will be 15 minutes prior to rental period.



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- There are separate spaces to allow for teams to get ready—the Harvest room and change rooms and near the far entrance to the ice surface.
- Players and participants will wait outside practicing physical distancing until being directed to proceed by arena staff.
- No personal belongings other than skates, water bottles, helmets, safety equipment and sticks will be allowed into the facility.
- o All **minor participants** must arrive dressed.
- All participants must sit in the designated, physically distanced spaces while tying skates and on the player benches.
- Change rooms will be available subject to reduced capacity. Only participants and designated representatives are permitted in change rooms. Capacity limits (9 individuals) will be posted on the door and must be adhered to. Access to the shared washrooms is permitted with reduced capacity and there will be no shower use.
 - The participants will enter and exit the rooms in sequence to avoid pinch points—the furthest chairs will enter first and leave last.
- All participants/spectators must leave the facility within 15 minutes following their rental time.
