Modified Game Play Fees Team Officials Qualifications

Modified Game Play Fees

As part of the Return to Hockey Framework, Stage 3 includes modified game play. This has been established to provide competitive modified programming while reducing the number of active participants on the ice, complying with health and safety guidelines. In light of these Modified Game Play Rules, the OMHA Board has reviewed HCOP Game Fees in this scenario.

The Fees and guidelines for game play as applicable with respect to U9 and below for modified ice (cross-ice and half-ice) remain as stated, but game length in these instances has been slightly adjusted to fit the framework.

The chart below can be used to guide Associations in implementing modified game play. The two scenarios are based on ice allocations of 1 or 1.5. hours, and include provision for pregame flood, 5-minute pre-game on-ice warm up, 1-minute intermission between periods, and 2 periods of equal length.

Recommended Fee Structure is as follows:

The Board has determined that Assistant Coaches require the same qualifications as Head Coaches per the current Team Official Qualification Chart, until such time as it confirmed that programming will enter into Stage 4 of Return to Hockey, at which time the Chart and requirements will be revisited.
